This instruction manual will help you install your Pic'n Style framing system on your wall.

Happy decorating!

Step 1.

Open the box you received with the frames and place the frames on a table or the floor.

Step 2.

Arrange the frames in the order you want them on the wall.

Step 3.

With a duster, clean the wall to remove any dust present.

Step 4.

Mark the area where you want to install the frames. If you are installing the frames over a piece of furniture, such as a cupboard or a chest of drawers, leave a gap of 40cm from the furniture's surface, and 10cm from either side of the furniture.




Step 5.

When installing the frames, always start from the lower left-hand side.

Step 6.

In the packaging you will find an L shape with a bubble level tool.



Step 7.

Put the tool to the lower left hand point where there will be the corner of the first frame.

Step 8.

Check that the L shape is levelled, peel off the black tape and press it to the wall.



Step 9.

Remove the L shape tool and move to the next frame (top or side). Place the lower part of the tool on the frame or on the side you just installed. Again, peel off the black tape and press to the wall. The tool will help you install the frames straight with a distance of 3cm in between.

Step 10.

Apply this technique to the remaining frames.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- It is important the wall is straight and painted with water paint.
- If the surface is not smooth and straight, the end result will be poor.
- The tool will help you to do the installation job properly and without damaging the wall.
- For short-term installation, use only the tape found at the top of the frame. For permanent installation, use tape found both at the top and the bottom.
